Managed Archery Hunt Proficiency Certification – City of Baxter, MN

Instructions: Once per three (3) years, hunters are required to take and pass a proficiency shooting test to demonstrate competence with their hunting equipment. Hunters must score a minimum of 16 points on a standard 5-spot target. This equates to shooting 4 of 5 arrows into a 6.25 inch bullseye. Prospective hunters are allowed two attempts per year to pass, with a minimum of 24 hours between attempts. Shooting distance will be 20 yards.

Hunters are required to:

- 1. Shoot the same bow they will use to hunt.
- 2. Shoot five (5) hunting arrows, i.e. no specialty target arrows (the size of broomsticks!).
- 3. Provide a copy of their Bowhunters Safety Card or other proof of having passed a Bow Safety Course.

Hunters can take their test any time during the dates given above at either <u>Archery Country</u>, <u>Beimert Outdoors</u> or another City-approved venue. Please call prior to heading out to ensure that someone will be around to administer your test.

All venues may charge a nominal fee.
